## Educational Programs

### Lutheran Elementary School

Christ-centered curriculum for **Kindergarten through 8th grade** in which all students are expected to maintain an enthusiastic attitude toward academics, developing the intellectual gifts that God has given them.

#### Preschool

- Available for 3-4 year olds.
- 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
- Preschool offered from 2 to 5 days with or without child care.
- Parents provide snack.

#### Child Care

- Available for 3-4 year olds.
- 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Child Care offered from 2 to 5 days with or without preschool.
- Parents provide lunch, snack is included for afternoon.

#### Latchkey Before and After School Care

- Offered to Cross of Glory students from Kindergarten to 8th grade during the school year on school days.
- 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Provides a safe and secure environment for children.
- Includes time for homework and study, free play and other activities.



## Curriculum

A school curriculum consists of all the learning experiences that come to the child through the school. Therefore, our curriculum strives to provide for the total needs of every child: the spiritual, the physical, the academic, and the social. So it is expressed in Luke 2:52: *“Jesus grew in wisdom (academic), and stature (physical), and in favor with God (spiritual) and men (social).”*

A full academic program is offered which complies with all of the requirements of the State of Michigan. This curriculum includes the language arts, reading, phonics, social studies, sciences, mathematics, the fine arts, and physical education.

Our curriculum is also Christ-centered. It includes daily devotions, weekly chapel services, Bible history, memory work from the Bible, catechism study, and hymn study. Scriptural truths are also integrated into all secular subjects as it is deemed appropriate by the teacher. The entire course of religion instruction is designed to lead to confirmation and continuous lifelong service to God.

## Tuition & Fees

**Tuition** - Tuition payments may be paid in one payment at the beginning of the school year or may be paid in monthly payments.

**Fees** - A non-refundable registration fee will be required of each student at the time of enrollment. This fee covers the costs of consumable material such as workbooks, yearbooks, paper, art supplies, etc. as well as field trips for the year. Additional fees for athletics, etc. will be paid at the time of registration.

**Tuition Assistance** - Please inquire about tuition assistance if needed. A form will be provided to assess the need and amount of assistance.
